3. Pearlettes

Category II: Scrapbook Presentations

***Scrapbooks may consist of photos, articles, ect., of the following club activities in the areas below. (Youth groups will not be judged separately. Overall club activities will be judges.)**

1. Youth/Club Meeting & Committee Activities
2. Cultural Activities
3. Social Activities
4. Educational Activities
5. Competitive Activities & Service Projects

Category III: *Memory Books (9th – 12th grades)

1. Archonettes (only)

***(required club contents and special contents of interest & memories to related to Black History Month activities are encouraged).**

Category II: Scrapbook Presentations

All Scrapbooks should be set up in the same order.

- 1. Title Page to include; Name of chapter, Address & Dates covered in scrapbook. Also, include which group(s) are represented in the scrapbook.**
- 2. Organization of Action Photos, Articles, Labels etc., and Activities Pertaining to:**
 - **Youth/Club Meeting and Committee Activities**
 - **Cultural Activities**
 - **Social Activities**
 - **Education Activities**
 - **Competitive Activities & Service Projects**

Please set up all scrapbooks in the above order – this will make the judging easier.

Please include captions and brief explanations of activities, if needed.

Category III: Archonette's Memory Book

(Special awards will be presented to the 3 "Best Archonettes' Memory Books) Judging will be based on the required contents, as indicated in the Archonette's Handbook, related content may also be added of Black History Month Activities.

Submission of Projects & Displays: All entries will be accepted on Friday evening or Saturday morning, upon your arrival at the Registration Table when you register. Please be sure to submit and mail your Zeta's Youth In Action Registration Form received in your packet in order to participate. Judging is schedules for Saturday.
